Below are two legislative bills which were introduced this year with the support of AASPA. The Respect, Advancement, and Increasing Support for Educators (RAISE) Act of 2022 would provide a refundable tax credit of up to \$15,000 to help boost salaries of early childhood, elementary, and secondary educators to reduce the teacher wage gap and ensure a high-quality education for all students.
