MOASPA-STL Scholarship for use in the 2021-2022 Academic Year

MOASPA-STL is a non-profit organization committed to helping St. Louis area school district human resource departments foster an educational environment to help children grow and learn. This scholarship is available to high school seniors attending a high school in an Education Plus/MOREAP affiliated school district who are interested in earning a Bachelor's Degree in Education. Funding use is limited to tuition and books. Two (2) \$1000 scholarships are available. A committee of MOASPA-STL members will review all applications and make their recommendations to the full MOASPA-STL membership. The recipient of this scholarship will be notified in May 2021.

Scholarship payments will be made directly to the approved educational institution.

When preparing your application, please be complete and concise. Type all information and respond appropriately to all items. All sections of the application must be complete. You may use additional paper as needed. Recipient selection will be based on a review of all sections of the application. The criteria for selection are inclusive of all students seeking a post-secondary education.

Scholarship Criteria

1.	Financial/Personal Circumstances	30 points
2.	Education Degree Pursuit and Goals	30 points
3.	Extra-Curricular Activities/Awards/Honors	15 points
4.	Letter of Recommendation	10 points
5.	Grade Point Average and Transcripts	15 points

- 1. Write a statement (100 words or less) describing your plans as they relate to your future education and goals towards a degree in education.
- 2. Describe (500 words or less) any circumstances from your family or personal life that would help in determining your need for these funds.
- 3. Describe in detail any of the following activities you may have been involved with during the past four years and include any awards/honors you may have received. For example:
 - Church and community activities. Include the name of the activities, events, organizations, committees, etc. Include the dates of involvement and what you did.
 - Leadership roles (i.e. officer, captain, chairperson, editor, etc.). Include the dates of leadership, group name, organization, etc.
 - Extracurricular school activities that meet or perform outside the school day.
 - Awards and honors for individual achievement.
 - Volunteer work.
 - Job History.

- 1. One letter of recommendation. This letter should be from a teacher in your high school who has had you as a student in his or her class.
- 2. A copy of your high school transcript to date.
